

KCB PICKLEBALL COURT REGULATIONS

MEMBER PLAY FROM 7:00AM – 12:00PM DAILY

Pickleball courts are owned by the City of Key Colony Beach and administrated by the Key Colony Beach Pickleball Club Inc. (KCBPC) per a management agreement with the Key Colony Beach Commissioners.

Pickleball courts are restricted to **KCB PICKLEBALL CLUB MEMBERS ONLY** between 7AM and 12PM daily from November 1 to April 30. The courts will be monitored during Members Only Play Periods. No singles play or non-club organized instruction will be permitted during Members Only Play Period. During heavy play periods the KCBPC may specify Regular Member priority over Limited Members and Day Pass users.

CHECK-IN:

All players must check in before placing their paddle in the rotation. Members must show their membership badge or be on the membership listing to play between 7am and 12pm. Non-Members can play by paying a Day Pass fee if the courts are not at capacity. See the court monitor regarding a Day Pass. Day Passes cannot be purchased in advance.

- **The Capacity Limit:** The maximum number of players playing OR waiting in the paddle rotation, or for the challenge court, is 8 players per court, i.e. 6 courts = 48 players. On Tuesdays and Thursdays when we only have 4 courts, the max is 32 players.

- **COURT MONITORS** will monitor court activity and capacity. When at maximum capacity Monitors will initiate wait list procedures. **Regular Members** will have priority play access over Limited Members and Day Pass users.

- **During maximum capacity play periods**, player time slots will be divided into two play periods, 7AM to 9:30AM and 9:30AM to 12PM. Players can only play in

one of these time slots, not both or any part of both. **At 9:30AM all games must end regardless of scores.**

- All courts must be used with the paddle system. Players cannot wait for a specific court.

Paddle Rotation:

All players must use the paddle line system when all courts are in use and other players are waiting.

- 4 paddles to a slot which designates the next group to get a court.
- ALL 4 players who have just completed a game must come off.
- Upon leaving a court after a game, players must place their paddle at end of the paddle line to play an additional game.
- All paddles must display the player's name.
- Players may only place one paddle at a time in paddle line.
- No player may touch any paddle in the paddle line other than their own.
- Players may group their paddles to play together but must play in paddle line slot order.
- Full groups of 4 must wait until the incomplete group ahead of them is filled and goes out to play unless the waiting players give them priority. The waiting group resumes the next up position.
- There will be no formal skill level segregation in the rotation.

Court # 4 may be designated as a “Challenge Court” 7AM to 9:30AM

- Challenge court is designated for 3.5 skill level and above.
- Challengers must place their 2 paddles in the rack next to court # 4 entry.
- Winners are not permitted to split up.
- Winners can only play a maximum of 2 consecutive games.
- Challenge Court games cannot start after 9:15 AM.
- If courts are at capacity, the monitor can terminate challenge court play.
- Challenge Court can be moved to court 5 or 6 after 9:30 if not at capacity, with approval of court monitor.

GOVERNANCE

COURT MONITORS:

Court Monitors will be volunteers from KCB Pickleball Club who routinely play on KCB courts and have demonstrated a good knowledge of these regulations to the KCBPC board. Court Monitors will serve throughout morning play and be identified with blue wrist bands to perform the following tasks:

- Greet and direct newcomers to the posted guidelines and provide procedures of the courts.
- Assist non-members with joining the club or purchasing a day pass.
- Track player counts to determine if the courts have reached the capacity limit.

When courts have reached the capacity limit, the COURT MONITOR will:

- Announce that games will be played to 9 points, win by 1 until further notice.

- Decide if Challenge Court should be terminated.
- Initiate wait list procedure with Regular Members in priority.
- Require EACH INDIVIDUAL arriving player, who chooses to wait, to sign in on the wait list and advise them when they can join in. **Regular Members have priority over limited members and Day Pass users.** Players may join in as players leave the courts.
- Answer questions and/or resolve any disputes regarding these regulations.
