KCB PICKLEBALL COURT REGULATIONS MEMBER PLAY FROM 7:00AM – 11:00AM DAILY November 1- April 30th

Pickleball courts are owned by the City of Key Colony Beach and administrated by the Key Colony Beach Pickleball Club Inc. (KCBPC) per a management agreement with the Key Colony Beach Commissioners.

Pickleball courts are restricted to KCB PICKLEBALL CLUB MEMBERS. <u>VISITORS are WELCOME</u>. We offer 1, 7 or 30-day passes for open play between 7AM and 11AM daily from November 1 to April 30.

Membership and visitor pass information can be found at our website at https://www.kcbpickleball.com/membership-plans. NOTE: Single day passes can only be purchased at the courts.

The courts will be managed by a club member during club play time. No singles play or non-club organized instruction will be permitted during Members Only Play period.

CHECK-IN:

All players must check in with the court greeter before placing their paddle in the rotation. Members must show their membership badge or be listed on the printed membership list located in the greeter kit to play between 7am and 11am. Non-Members can play by paying for a 1, 7 or 30-day day pass. Single day passes cannot be purchased in advance.

Paddle Rotation:

All players must use the paddle line system when all courts are in use and other players are waiting.

- 4 paddles to a slot which designates the next group to get a court.
- ALL 4 players who have just completed a game must come off.
- Upon leaving a court after a game, players must place their paddle at end of the paddle line to play an additional game.
- All paddles must display the player's name.
- Players may only place one paddle at a time in paddle line.

- No player may touch any paddle in the paddle line other than their own.
- Players may group their paddles to play together but must play in paddle line slot order.
- Full groups of 4 must wait until the incomplete group ahead of them is filled and goes out to play unless the waiting players give them priority. The waiting group resumes the next up position.

Courts 1-6 are designated for Beginner to Intermediate play.

Courts 7-10 are designated for Advanced play. Courts 9 & 10 of are designated as "Challenge Courts"

- Challenge court is designated for 3.75 skill level and above.
- Challengers must place their 2 paddles in the rack between the two courts.
- Winners are not permitted to split up.
- Winners can only play a maximum of 2 consecutive games.
- Losers always exit.

GOVERNANCE - COURT GREETERS:

Court Greeters will be volunteers from KCB Pickleball Club who routinely play on KCB courts and have demonstrated a good knowledge of these regulations to the KCBPC board. Court Greeters will serve throughout morning play and be at the facility entrance to perform the following tasks:

- Greet and direct newcomers to the posted guidelines and provide procedures of the courts.
- Assist non-members with joining the club or purchasing a visitor pass.
- Answer questions and/or resolve any disputes regarding these regulations.
